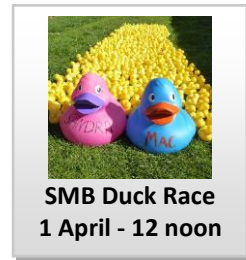

Referendum on St Mary Bourne Parish Neighbourhood Plan 20th February 2018

Result: YES

YES: 288 (85.97%)

NO: 44 (13.13%)

3 votes rejected - total turnout 31.31%

As more than 50% of individuals voted 'yes' in the referendum, Basingstoke and Deane Borough Council will 'make' the St Mary Bourne Neighbourhood Plan. It will help determine planning applications in the St Mary Bourne Neighbourhood Area. It will also form part of the statutory development plan for Basingstoke and Deane.
